

# Bible Club Crafts Instructions

Dear Team Leaders and Members,

Thank you so much for your willingness to serve in the Street Reach Ministries!

Part of your Bible Club sessions will involve crafts. Much time, prayer and preparation has gone into assisting your group for a smooth running craft session each day. Unless instructed otherwise, please follow the plans provided for your craft session each day. **We are asking that you try as much as possible to provide the materials needed to complete each day's suggested craft activity.** Please plan for supplies that will allow for at least **80** children at each assigned site each day. Because the Bible Clubs are outside in vacant lots, tables are not available (unless you provide them) Children assemble the crafts while sitting on the ground on tarps. Power is also not available at the Bible Club Site so any craft needing the use of power for assembly will need to be done prior to the trip or at the housing facility.

If your group would like to bring extra coloring pages, Fruit Loops, macaroni, or beads for making preschool necklaces, you might use these when you need an extra activity or for the younger children who have short attention spans.

Because of the nature of Street Reach, the children require close supervision and assistance. You may have an activity that requires you to cut out materials before you arrive at your site. We do not encourage the children using scissors or other sharp objects at the site.

Please understand that these craft activities are for suggestions only. You have the option of providing your own crafts for our kids. If you wish to use our craft suggestions, you may want to cut out and assemble some of the pieces together prior to arriving in order to have enough time for the children to finish. It's strongly suggested if using our crafts, you assemble most of the project for the younger children prior to coming. Typically the children are at the "craft" station for, at most, 15 minutes.

Be assured that the Street Reach staff will be here to assist you and we will be praying for your team as you prepare to come to Memphis.
