GENERAL INFORMATION AND EXPECTATION DECLARATION

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!!!

Thank you for your interest in the Street Reach 2009 ministry! My name is Jason Cox. God has blessed me greatly by allowing me to be associated with Street Reach as a summer college missionary, a past project director in Ft. Smith, AR, and by choosing me to be the director of Street Reach 2008! We believe this year has been very successful in that God is being glorified as over 500 impoverished children are being ministered to and given God's plan of salvation. We had 24 mission teams participate at our Memphis, TN ministry site.

We are now enlisting mission teams for spring and summer 2009. All weeks for spring and summer 2009 are available. We will begin our **spring session** during the week of March 8 and our final week will begin on April 12. **The summer session** will begin June 8 and end on July 31.

The greatest advantage at Street Reach 2009 for your consideration when choosing a site for your mission project is that the cost of the week will be **all-inclusive**. Once Street Reach receives your SIGNED Application and a nonrefundable team deposit of \$100.00 and each of your team members has paid the per person cost of: **SPRING SESSION - \$185.00 or SUMMER SESSION - \$235.00 the following will occur:**

What STREET REACH will provide:

- **housing** for your team:

Spring teams will be housed at our outreach center. You will need to bring air mattresses, pillow, linens, and bath towels. Restrooms with showers are provided as well as a full size kitchen.

Summer teams will have dorm style facilities, bunks with mattresses(need to bring pillow, linens and towels). Our summer housing facility has restrooms with showers, a gymnasium, meeting rooms but **does not have kitchen facilities!**

- **food** for your team (includes arrival pizza party on Sunday evening, light breakfast foods each morning (ie:cereal,toast,pastries,milk,oj,coffee), light lunches (ie:sandwiches,chips,snacks,drinks,deserts),and catered evening dinners (ie:hot,full-course meals on three weekday nights).

- **supplies** for all community service projects your team may be assigned to accomplish.

- **the curriculum** for the site bible clubs, **all supplies** to run the sites(including games and songs). **However, we ask for you to provide crafts for each bible club site that you run. We can provide craft ideas and a supply list if needed.**

What STREET REACH will provide (Continued from Page One):

- **for Summer teams only:** a pre-project orientation day, on-site, for you and your staff (you provide transportation and lodging, if needed) The Pre-project date is **tentatively** set for Saturday, April 25, 2009. **NOTE: There is NO pre-project orientation for the spring session.**

- **Street Reach staff site missionaries** (student summer missionaries) will coordinate each mission site (i.e., Bible clubs, sports camps, light construction projects, community service projects). **NOTE: Staff site missionaries are available for summer session only.**

- **a Sunday night orientation** to be led by staff director to acquaint your team members with rules and regulations, area customs and taboos, curriculum, music, and daily itineraries.

- **evening worship, praise & share times** led by the staff missionaries.

- **one night during week will have no scheduled activities** to allow teams to plan their own sightseeing activities.

- **free housing for one extra night (Friday)** at our dorm facility, if desired. You will be free to leave for home following lunch on Friday (no afternoon projects are scheduled), but are invited to remain one extra night if you want to sightsee, etc. and leave Saturday. (NOTE: meals will not be provided after lunch on Friday)

- **a video presentation CD** of your week at Street Reach (still photos taken by our staff at each site during the week. Please allow four weeks after August 9, 2008 for the delivery of your CD)

What YOU and your leaders are to provide:

- **spiritual preparation** of your team.

- **for Summer Teams Only:** participation in the pre-project orientation day by you and/or your staff. Pre-Project orientation is currently set for Saturday, April 26, 2008 and is **MANDATORY!** If you cannot get at least one of your leaders to Memphis please budget expenses to pay for one of our staff to travel to your location for a Pre-project Orientation session with your leaders.

- **authority, leadership, and responsibility** at all times over each member of your team.

- **submission of a signed 2008 Team Application and team deposit** to secure your mission week(s). Teams will be guaranteed space on a first-come first-served basis only with their signed 2008 Team Application and a \$100 non-refundable team deposit.

What YOU and your leaders are to provide (Continued from Page Two):

- **Participant fees must be received at Street Reach** before March 1, 2009 for **Spring Trip** or May 1, 2009 for **Summer Trip**. A team roster and all remaining forms contained in this packet should be sent with your total balance amount. We **STRONGLY** discourage deletions to roster after this date. Cancellation penalties will apply. Early pre-payment of balance in full cheerfully accepted!

PLEASE NOTE AND ADD TO YOUR PRAYER LIST: OUR MINISTRY IS A YEAR-ROUND MINISTRY THAT IS FULLY AND WHOLLY SUPPORTED BY YOUR FEES! YOUR FEES WILL ALLOW US TO MINISTER TO THE CHILDREN AND FAMILIES OF OUR COMMUNITY LONG AFTER YOUR MISSION WEEK(S) ARE COMPLETED!

- **transportation of all team members** to and from Memphis and local mission sites where your members are participating.

- **one evening meal for your team during the week**, you will be having one night off (tentatively set as Wednesday evening) for attending area church prayer services or for sight-seeing,

- **equipment and supplies** for any games or music that your team would like to provide in addition to ours.

- **provide crafts for each bible club site** that you run. We can provide craft ideas and a supply list if needed. We will also provide the expected number of crafts needed for each mission site you are assigned to.

New 2009 policies:

Effective August 2, 2008 Street Reach dorm "check in" will take place on Sunday afternoon between the times of 1:00 pm and 7:00 **ONLY**. All teams will be required to participate in Sunday evening Street Reach Orientation. Saturday dorm "check in" is also available during the hours of 6:00-10:00 pm.
